

# Reading your ebook: viewing it online vs. downloading it

There are two ways to view and read an ebook; you can either **view it online** or **download** the ebook to your mobile device. Each method offers different advantages, and the one you select will depend on how you will be using the ebook.

## View ebook online

- Viewing an ebook online uses less storage space compared to downloading it
- Some online ebooks allow multi-user access
- Some ebook providers allow you to search within the online ebook, highlight sections and take notes
- An internet connection is required every time you want to view an online ebook.
- To quickly check a page or a quote, viewing content online via a desktop PC is quicker than downloading the entire ebook to your mobile device,

## Download an ebook

- Downloading an ebook allows you to view the book offline, so it can be viewed anytime, anywhere and no internet connection is required.
- You do not need to remember to return the ebook. After a specified loan period, the ebook will automatically be removed from your mobile device.
- As well as downloading whole books, some providers allow you to download specific pages or chapters.
- If the ebook has already been downloaded by another user, some providers allow you to reserve the ebook, so that you can download it once it becomes available again.
